A Matter of Perspective Affordable caravan mirrors by Rameder

A person will need to acquire a different set of driving skills when towing a camper or some other type of large trailer for the first time: A greater turning circle is required, the rear view is partially blocked, and backing up is more difficult. One should always allow a generous safety distance to parked cars and oncoming traffic. Mounting requires neither drilling nor screws: Practical tensioning elements ensure a quick attachment that will not damage the car. The mirrors can be attached on both sides; **Rameder** recommends using the mirrors as a pair. In fact, additional mirrors may even be obligatory in some countries or at least some cases: Although paragraph 56 of the German Road Traffic Registration Ordinance does, for example, not specifically stipulate this, it does suggest their usage: "Motor vehicles must have [...] 2 to 3 mirrors or other equipment for indirect viewing, and these mirrors must be [...] attached in such a way so that the vehicle operator [...] can observe all relevant traffic occurrences while driving – and also while hauling a trailer."
