Transport of water sports equipment

The clever kayak, canoe and surfboard carriers from Rameder

Outdoor sports are currently very popular. And now, as temperatures are rising, many water sports enthusiasts – and those just starting out – are planning their kayaking or canoing trips. But how to get the sports equipment to the ocean or river? Rameder – Europe's largest supplier for car transport solutions – can help. And of course Rameder also has the right carrier systems so surfers and stand-up paddlers can transport their boards on their cars.

Anyone who uses a double paddle is in a kayak. A safe and cost-efficient way to transport these to the destination is the Kayak carrier Niagara for only 89 euros. With the provided T-slot nuts, it can be quickly attached to the roof bars. The shape is suitable for a variety of different boat types. The two support bars are made of robust steel and are suitable even for heavier models. Lashing straps are provided for securing the hull. When not in use, the compact brackets can be folded for easy storage.

Flexible transport of kayaks, canoes and stand-up paddle boards? For this target group, Rameder has developed the Portage 819 at a price of 117 euros. The compact design generates only little wind noise. The weather-resistant padding protects the water sports equipment during the journey. Robust lashing straps protect the vehicle as well as kayak & Co. against scratches.

Owners of particularly high-quality "paddle boats" should choose the Hull-a-Port Aero 849 for 256 euros. While the name might sound more like an airplane, this is a carrier with theft protection. The canoe or kayak can travel in this carrier safely and well protected by an extra-soft rubber pad.

Surfers should go for the Board Shuttle 811 (181 euros). This rack features a modern telescopic design and excellent handling. It can perfectly accommodate two boards with a width of up to 86 cm. Sturdy lashing straps with all-round padding provide secure fastening for the precious boards. Whether you want to set out on a surfboard or stand-up paddle board, in a canoe or in a kayak – Rameder ensures secure and cost-efficient transport of all water sports equipment.
